Directed Study (As Described in the BHS Teacher Handbook)

Directed Study is a block of time that provides students an opportunity to read, study, and complete assignments during the school day. The following expectations are to ensure a QUIET, PRODUCTIVE atmosphere and to provide each student the chance to utilize this time WITHOUT DISTRUBANCE FROM OTHERS. Directed Study is NOT a time to socialize, sleep, or waste.

- 1. Be seated and ready for work when the bell rings. SEATS WILL BE ASSIGNED.
- 2. Bring supplies, books, assignments, agenda, etc. EACH DAY. BE PREPARED.
- 3. Use the time productively.
- 4. Be respectful and courteous to your peers AND to the teacher.
- 5. You will NOT report to another classroom, office, library...THIS IS YOUR SPACE FOR THE SEMESTER. Discretion will be used in special circumstances for students who have legitimate reason to visit another space.
- 6. Cell phone policy is in effect for directed study.

Student assistants WILL be removed from the class roster for Directed Study and assigned to specific staff member using their services.

Additional Directed Study Information: Students should be working at all times. This means that students need to come with class materials to work on. Students should not be on non-school related sites, such as YouTube, streaming services, or game websites.

Dual Enrollment

- Dual enrollment students are to work on their online course materials and maintain focus on their assignments during class.
- Students should attend class with their charged Chromebook each day.
- The course material is designed to be online with an online teacher. Mr. Mayo may or may not be able to assist with the course material, as he is in the room to monitor the class.

Band Room Directed Study Procedures

- Students will set up tables and chairs in the area described by Mr. Mayo
- Students will read, study, or work quietly.
- At the end of the class, students will put away tables and chairs.
- Students will not pass the inner-most exit sign while waiting on dismissal.

Band Room Rules

- Do not touch, play, or place anything on top of the musical instruments and/or risers.
- No open speakers. Please use headphones if your assignment calls for sound.
- Students should not lay their heads down and/or fall asleep at any time.
